## Q & A

### Training Level—What does it mean?

Kentucky has defined training as "structured learning experiences designed to help the learner gain knowledge and/or skills that will increase the implementation of high quality practices" . Think of Training Levels as a ladder..... beginning at Training Level 1 (Awareness /Introduction to ChildCare) and progressing UP the ladder to Training Level 5 (Advanced with several years of experience).

### I work with Infants and Toddlers, is it OK for me to attend a workshop designed for Preschool age?

It is not appropriate. Workshop content planned for teachers of ages 3-5 years will not benefit your children.
